**ISA President Fernando Aguerre** officially declared open the **2018 Stance ISA World Adaptive Surfing Championship** presented by the City of San Diego in La Jolla, USA at the event's Opening Ceremony.

A record-breaking 120 athletes from 24 nations participated in the ISA's one-of-a-kind Parade of Nations and Sands of the World Ceremony.
