After eight days of world-class longboarding in Biarritz, France, the host nation continued to dominate their home break to earn the Team Gold Medal at the 2019 ISA World Longboard Surfing Championship.

France was led by an incredible four-medal performance, highlighted by Alice's Lemoigne's Gold Medal victory in the Women's Division. Peru's Benoit 'Piccolo' Clemente, the 2018 Silver Medalist, earned his first ISA Gold Medal in the Men's Division, needing a dramatic 7.7 ride to surpass France's Delpero brothers and overtake the pole position.
