Sunday morning at the **2017 ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championship** proved to be another historic day for the sport of SUP and country of Denmark, as the local hero, **Casper Steinfath**, emerged victorious in the 200-meter SUP Sprints and was crowned World Champion.

The SUP Sprint Gold Medal is the second consecutive and fifth ISA Title for Steinfath, who also has been a leader in advancing the sport of SUP, serving as the ISA Vice President since 2014.

**ISA President, Fernando Aguerre** chimed in on the historic day of competition.

“What a couple of days here in Denmark. It’s been a week of firsts: The first time for this event in Europe, the first time Denmark has hosted an ISA event, first SUP World Championship with gender equality, the first time a Danish woman has won a medal, and the first time that Casper Steinfath has won a Gold Medal at home. That’s special.
