SUP Surfing World Champions were crowned on Thursday at the **2017 ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championship** in Vorupør, Denmark.

Australia's **Shakira Westdorp** repeated as the Women's World Champion, following up on her historic 2016 performance in Fiji, while Brazil's **Luiz Diniz** burst into the international spotlight in his first appearance in the event, bringing a Gold Medal to Team Brazil.
