Team Brazil's **Arthur Santacreu** and South Africa's **Tarryn King** respectively earned the Men's and Women's SUP Sprint Gold Medals at the ISA World SUP and Paddleboard Championship in Wanning, China.

King's performance is the first-ever Gold Medal for South Africa and comes just over a year after giving birth and recovering to a world-class level for SUP Surfing. King's husband Thomas celebrated on the beach with their 1-year son.

With two Bronze Medals for USA and only one Copper Medal for Australia in the Sprint Races, USA built upon their lead with five medals remaining to be awarded.
